As the violence spins out of control, the federal agencies and the authorities in Miami send one agent to Mexico to search for answers from the violet Mexican drug cartels. The other agent goes to Japan to question the Yamaguchi-gumi crime syndicate and its yakuza rivals. During the absence of the two agents, a sex-crazed Mafia drug lord kidnaps their wife and girlfriend. The agents return to confront the kidnapper in a bloody conclusion that uncovers the mystery of the ship, its cargo, and the identity of the ninja bosses.
