Source citations in the Turabian manual come in two varieties: (1) notes and bibliography (or simply notes) and (2) author-date. These two systems are also sometimes referred to as Chicago-style citations, because they are the same as the ones presented in The Chicago Manual of Style.

All citations should be double spaced and have a hanging indent. A "hanging indent" means that each subsequent line after the first line of your citation should be indented by 0.5 inches.

General Model for Citing Web Sources in Chicago Style Titles for Web Sources: The title of a website that is analogous to a traditionally printed work but does not have (and never had) a printed counterpart can be treated like titles of other websites. For example, Wikipedia can be treated as a website, rather than as a conventional encyclopedia.

AAA Style Guide As of September 2015, AAA style (for all publications) follows the Chicago Manual of Style, 17th edition, particularly in regard to reference citations, which are summarized below.

Publishing Style Guide - Stay Informed

If the writer of the piece is different from the author of the complete work, then start the citation with the author of the introduction or foreword, and write the full name of the principal work's author after the title of the work.

In notes, CMOS prefers the abbreviation of "editor (s)" as "ed." or "eds.," and translator (s) as "trans." In bibliographic entries, these abbreviations are not used. Instead, titles are spelled out in full. This information appears in The Chicago Manual of Style, section 14.103.

Books // Purdue Writing Lab

Chicago footnotes provide a note each time a source is referenced and are often combined with a bibliography at the end. If you use a bibliography: You do not need to provide the full citation in the footnotes, but rather a shortened form of the citation. The reader can consult your bibliography to find the full reference.
