3 Quick Methods for Preserving Old Books

Maintain a minimum amount of lighting wherever you're storing the books. Cover fluorescent fixtures, windows and other openings with UV filters. 6. Digitize Them! This is the best technique for preserving old books! Digitize them either by finding a book scanning services or by doing it manually. The former method is preferred because it offers better quality, eliminates all the hassles and takes less time.

How to store and preserve old books?

Preserve Your Vintage Magazines To repair bent or folded magazine pages and covers, unbend or unfold the page and place it under a stack of heavy books, like encyclopedias. Leave for a day or more, depending on the severity of the fold. Wrap the magazine in a new, clear plastic dust jacket, found at hobby and collectible stores.

Store old books (or any book you want to pay extra attention to) out of direct sunlight. If your shelves are in sunlight and there's nothing you can do about it, wrap the dust jacket in a UV-resistant plastic book cover (available at craft stores or online).

West suggests removing both front and back covers and reconnecting them using archival tape placed along the inside fold. Next, lay the body of the magazine into the covers, like a folder, and secure it in front and back with archival tape. To preserve the magazine in the future, West advises storing it in an archival plastic sleeve.

For very old, delicate books, avoid pressing the vacuum directly to the book's surface; instead, allow it to hover just above the surface, moving slowly and gently from side to side. 2

Climate and Humidity. Vintage editions are especially susceptible to minor fluctuations in temperature and humidity. To deter from disintegration or flaws in the paper or binding, keep temperatures between 65–70 degrees Fahrenheit, with humidity levels at a steady 30–50 percent.
