Although the desert cottontail resembles most other cottontails, its ears are much larger. This grey rabbit with rufous nape and white tail weighs around 2 pounds (900 grams). It is the only cottontail in the Sonoran Desert. The antelope jackrabbit is one of the largest hares in North America, weighing 9 to 10 pounds (4.5 kg).
